- 1. Presentation: Jeanna Miller, Parkside Elementary Principal A tour of the remodeled areas was provided.
- Preliminary Tax Levy Update, Ryan Tangen, Director of Finance and Operations Will ask to approve the maximum at the September 27th board meeting. Current levy is projected at \$19,626,212.18 which is down \$507,337.89 (2.52%) over the prior year. Adjusted Pupil Units is projected to decrease by 145 students from 2021-22 to 2022-23. With market values going up and our student numbers going down, the value per student is higher. A \$200,000 home in 2020, assuming the value increased this year to \$210,000, will see a decrease of about \$33 this year.
- 3. Bond Refunding, Ryan Tangen, Director of Finance and Operations Able to refund the bonds since we are within 90 days of the February 1, 2022 call date. Projecting a 4.368% savings or \$394,111.48 with the interest rate decreasing from 4% to .39%. This will be another savings to our taxpayers. A representative from Ehlers will present this at the September 27th meeting.
- 4. 2021-22 1st Day Enrollment, Scott Thielman, Superintendent This is a look at the first day of school enrollment. The official enrollment for funding purposes will be taken on October 1st. Elementary is at 2256 (down 26 from a projection of 2282). Middle school is at 1201 (down 39 from a projection of 1240) and the High School is at 1919 (101 above projection of 1818 – all students are counted as 1.0 FTE in this number. This will be adjusted in the October 1st count.).
