The second step in the application process is to participate in a personal interview with our scholarship committee. Locations and dates for these interviews will vary as new circumstances arise. However, we will be flexible for all interviews. The scholarship weekend will be held **April 5th-6th**. The goal for this scholarship weekend would be for the applicants to build relationships with other high-quality men before they attend the University of Minnesota, visit the campus, and make valuable connections with upperclassmen.

If you are unfamiliar with us, FarmHouse is an international fraternity open to students of all majors and backgrounds.
