What is the AVID Elective?

 Academic elective course that prepares students for college readiness and success. In AVID, students participate in activities that incorporate strategies focused on writing, inquiry, collaboration, organization, and reading to support their academic growth!



What is the AVID Elective?

Students engage in activities centered around exploring college and career opportunities and their own agency. Graduates who have completed two or more years in AVID classes, including their senior year, will wear a silver cord at graduation to indicate their involvement.
