Definition of First-Generation College Student at SMUMN

FGI Scholarship Coverage

The First Generation Scholarship at Saint Mary's Univ. of MN is a full ride scholarship that includes the following:

- 1. Saint Mary's admission deposit
- 2. Full tuition for four years, 8 semesters at Saint Mary's University of Minnesota
- 3. Basic room and board for four years
- 4. Laptop for the four years at SMUMN
- 5. Graduation fee

Step 2: Complete the FAFSA

Be sure to enter Saint Mary's school code, 002380

Step 3: Turn in the FGI Application (Application Form, Essay, and Recommendation)

- 3. Show, don't tell. Stories speak to the heart and engage the mind of your readers.
- 4. Let your passion, determination, and perseverance shine in your examples and stories.
- **5.** Examples of hardships you have experienced and how you have overcome them are indicative of your determination to succeed.

The use of AI generated essay's is prohibited and will result in disqualification.

FGI Scholarship Essay Prompt:

Describe yourself as a new student at Saint Mary's University of Minnesota. What personal characteristics will you bring and contribute to the Saint Mary's community? How have past experiences helped shape who you are (family, culture, faith, church, school, community, etc.)? What do you want to achieve during your time at Saint Mary's?

FGI Letter of Recommendation

Please collect at least 1 letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, or employer. Letters of recommendation can be attached to student application, or can be sent directly to fgi@smumn.edu.

The letter of recommendation should address the following:

How do you know the scholarship applicant?
What sets the scholarship applicant apart from other students their age?
What is the scholarship applicant's aptitude for success?
When faced with hardship, how does the scholarship applicant respond?
What are the greatest strengths of the scholarship applicant? Opportunities for growth?
