

Taking the Class D Written Knowledge Test



Schedule an In-Person Appointment

1. To schedule at the Wright County Government Center (3650 Braddock Ave NE) visit **co.wright.mn.us** and **scroll down to “Make an Appointment”**.
2. To schedule at the Department of Public Safety Buffalo Exam Station (1006 Commercial Drive), visit **dps.mn.gov** and select **“Schedule a Written or Road Test”**
3. Follow the prompts.
4. The test center will collect the **Blue Card** at your testing appointment.

Come Prepared:

Students should come prepared. Visit the **Need Help?** section on the **onlineservices.dps.mn.gov** website for updates.

- You must be at least 15 years old.
- Bring your **Certificate of Enrollment (Blue Card)** proving you completed classroom instruction.
- Bring all required documents such as Certified Birth Certificate or Passport. Visit **dps.mn.gov** for list of approved documents.
- A parent, court-appointed guardian, county-appointed foster parent or the director of the transitional living program you reside in will need to attend with you to sign and approve your application.
- Know your social security number.
- Bring payment to pay any fees, if applicable.
